This piece is written in the blues scale. All Fs should be roughly halfway between F \sharp and F \natural , and played with a falling tone. All Cs should be played halfway between C \sharp and C \natural using a constant pitch, and play long notes with a slow vibrato. Because of this, all the D and A chords are not exactly minor. For the guitar playing the tune, this piece starts in the third position. If playing without the blues inflection, Ds are Dm and A(bl) is A9(no3) (see the "low tune" version), but the Cs really do want to be half-sharp!
